With heavy hearts, we announce the death of Frank Allen Aubrecht, a loving husband, father, grandpa and cherished friend. Frank passed away peacefully, at home, surrounded by love on February 19, 2025.

Born on June 26, 1954 in Cleveland, Ohio, he was a life long resident of Valley View, where he grew up and continued to live in the same house his grandparents had built in 1922. He attended school in Cuyahoga Heights but finished his senior year at Cathedral Latin in Cleveland and graduated in 1972. He made his career as an electrician, having retired in 2009.

Frank had a generous heart and was a supporter of the Down Syndrome Association of Northeast Ohio, Doctors Without Borders and Scleroderma Research. He was a Harley Davidson guy from a young age and loved telling stories about his rides and adventures with anyone who would listen. He was a talented painter, after his father, and shared his art with everyone.

Frank loved his family immensely and had a sense of humor that touched everyone. He had the best laugh and was always ready with a hug or pat on the back. His most favorite times were family camping trips and throwing in a line but also cherished any time we had family parties at the house, playing Pictionary and dice games. We usually ended those times with his favorite bar song by David Allen Cole, You Never Even Called Me by My Name, with

Frank singing the loudest.

Frank was preceded in death by his mother, Lois E. Aubrecht (nee Rice), father Frank C. Aubrecht, Sisters Janice Gosselin and Diana Saraniti and daughter-in-law Jessica Hudson (nee Harriot).
