Jack M. Fisher, 90, of Hiram, passed away peacefully on May 18, 2025. Jack's life was marked by craftsmanship, ingenuity, and independence. His love of machines began early, helping his father build midget race cars that ran at Sportsman's Park. He went on to work as a machine designer for companies like Lincoln Electric and Kennametal. In the 1970s, Jack bought an 11-acre farm where he restored vintage cars — some dating back to 1914.
