Robert James Meffe, 69, of Macedonia, Ohio, died at his home on May 9, 2024. He was born in Rahway, New Jersey, on June 7, 1954, to William and Emma (nee Litchco) Meffe. Bob was an avid Harley enthusiast, enjoying rides with his son and friends and volunteering his time with the H.O.G. club at Southeast Harley. Bob was preceded in death by his parents, William and Emma Meffe, and his brother, Kenneth Meffe. He is survived by his sons, Michael (Teresa) Meffe and Robert M.
